Both companies were acquired in 2012 by Illinois-based Landmarc Environmental Systems, for which Chappel acted as managing principal from 2012 to 2016.

Glenn Wieczorek, managing director for Tsurumi, said that Chappel will thrive in his new role as a result of his technical prowess and sales abilities.

"Doug has an entrepreneurial spirit that will serve him well at Tsurumi," he said. "He has run two companies of his own and knows what it takes to generate sales and maintain relationships.
